Dr. Kakade offers a variety of procedures at Story Medical to include joint replacement surgery of the hip, knee, and shoulder; trauma and fracture surgery of the hip, wrist, shoulder, and extremities; care for sports medicine injuries in the shoulders, knees, and ankles; carpal tunnel surgery; and more.

A fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow in Scotland, Dr. Kakade is also a member of the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons (AAOS), Iowa Orthopedic Society, American Medical Association, and Indian Orthopedic Association.

Dr. Folkers provides advanced treatment for a variety of conditions affecting the hands, including carpal tunnel syndrome, fractures of the hand, and other conditions like arthritis, and nerve and tendon injuries.

He also provides a range of services to patients seeking cosmetic procedures.

In addition to his work in the operating room and clinic, Dr. Folkers has been published numerous times and is participating in a number of on-going research studies that keep him on the cutting edge of medicine to serve his patients better. Dr. Folkers is also an inventor, engaged in the development of several surgical design systems.

Proudly Playing a Key Role in COVID Vaccine Effort

A major milestone in the fight against the coronavirus pandemic was reached on December 23, 2020 when Dr. Art Check received the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine administered by Crystal Swartzlander, RN, BSN.

Since that date, Story Medical has stepped up in a big way to support the vaccination effort in Story County. In addition to vaccinating staff members, Story Medical has delivered thousands of shots to individuals throughout the county.

"The efforts of many made this breakthrough possible and as an organization we are optimistic and excited that this is the beginning of the end of the pandemic," says Dr. Check. "This has been a historic effort and we are proud of the role we are playing in protecting our community members."

Public distribution of the vaccine began in February with the shot delivered to those 65 and older deemed to be at most risk. To facilitate efficient distribution of the vaccine, the Story Medical Clinic staff worked tirelessly to contact all patients who matched the criteria to receive the vaccine. In addition, a multidisciplinary team at Story Medical developed a web-based form to allow those in the community who were not clinic patients to enter a queue to receive the shot when it was available. More than 1,200 community members entered the queue, with the vast majority of them receiving the shot at Story Medical.

"From the start, our goal was to vaccinate as many people as we possbily could, even if that meant offering it to those who were not our current patients," Dr. Check says. "I cannot say enough about how efficient the process has been. The entire medical community in Story County came together in the interest of those who live here. It has been an awesome process to be a part of."

Story Medical Clinic will continue to manage the vaccination process in accordance with CDC guidelines.
