A familiar face is returning to town to serve the community. In August, Nevada native Audra (Lloyd) Poterucha, D.O., will begin practicing at Story Medical Clinic - Nevada, joining us as a full-time member of our medical staff.

"The addition of Dr. Poterucha will allow us to grow and enhance the services we provide to the community," says Nate Thompson, Story Medical CEO. "We are excited to bring a provider back to town who has roots here. In an area like this, that type of connection is a big deal."

Dr. Poterucha is a graduate of Nevada High School and Iowa State University. She earned her medical degree from Des Moines University and recently completed a Family Medicine Residency at Broadlawns Medical Center in Des Moines.

Early in her schooling, Dr. Poterucha job shadowed Dr. Art Check at Story Medical. The experience opened her eyes to the possibilities here.

"I didn't come into the shadowing thinking I would get hired here, but it felt right," she says. "For me that showed me I liked the environment and the small town feel of it."

She says she is excited to practice in a town she loves so much.

"I like to see people in different contexts outside of the clinic," Dr. Poterucha says. "I like to see them at church, at a high school game, or the grocery store. I want to be more than a provider, I want to be a part of the community."

# 'Every link in the chain' leads to an Exceptional Outcome

April 4, 2018 started like any other day for Doug Hix. He and his wife, Teresa, planned to spend the day in Colo visiting her parents. Little did they know the trip, similar to others they had made hundreds of times before, would find Doug fighting for his life.

Shortly after arriving in Colo, Doug went into cardiac arrest.

"I just dropped over," Doug says. "My wife started CPR immediately and my mother-in-law, who is 94 years old, called 911."

The 911 call was routed to Story Medical and an ambulance was dispatched immediately. Within minutes, the paramedic team took over CPR from the Colo First Responders, stabilized Doug, and rushed him to Story Medical.

Upon arriving at Story Medical, the care team led by Dr. Art Check, delivered a shock to restart Doug's heart, stabilized him and prepared him for transfer via helicopter to UnityPoint Health - Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines. Story Medical has the only on-site

helipad in Story County, making the transfer to a more advanced level of care in Des Moines more efficient.

"While I don't remember much of anything, I've been told that I had to be shocked six more times on the flight to Des Moines," Doug says. "I have no doubt that the people at Story Medical saved me."

Doug was in the hospital in Des Moines for a month. He had a pacemaker with a defibrillator implanted to prevent a re-occurrence and started Cardiac Rehab at Story Medical as soon as he could.

"It was recommended I do cardiac rehab in Des Moines, but I told them I wanted to go to Story Medical," Doug says. "The doctors kept me from dying, but it was the cardiac rehab team at Story Medical that gave me my life back.

"I'm back to where I was before and I couldn't be happier with the outcome," he continues. "Without every link in the chain, I wouldn't be here."

# New Ambulance Enhances Care for Patients, Safety for Providers

There is a new addition to the fleet of ambulances at Story

Medical. In June, the medical center took delivery of the new vehicle, which will replace the older of the two current ambulances in use. Emergency Department Supervisor Susan Hofmeyer says the new ambulance offers a number of enhancementsfor both the patient and the care team.

"This ambulance is better designed, especially in the area where we are providing care," Hofmeyer says. "The patient is much more accessible to our paramedics and EMTs. And as an added safety feature, our providers are able to strap into a

harness and still have full access to the patient on the go."


Other safety enhancements include a full LED lighting system, a hydraulic lift that can raise or lower the entire ambulance to accommodate loading or unloading a patient in different situations, and a "power load" system that allows patients to be loaded

automatically with the push of a button.

Story Medical has two ambulances in service and provides paramedic coverage 24/7 to communities including Nevada, Colo, Cambridge, Maxwell, McCallsburg, Zearing, and Collins, among others.
