New Specialty Provider **Todd Troll, M.D.** Joins Story Medical

Todd Troll, M.D., has joined the medical staff of Story Medical and is seeing patients in the Story Medical Outpatient Clinic. A specialist in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Dr. Troll is a member of the Iowa Clinic.

Dr. Troll earned his undergraduate degree from Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, his medical degree from the University of Indiana, and completed his residency at the Medical College of Ohio in Toledo. He is certified by the American Board of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation.

"I did a rotation in my fourth-year of residency in physical medicine and rehabilitation and I knew that was it," Dr. Troll says. "I knew that is what I wanted to do."

Physicians specializing in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation—also commonly referred to as physiatry—aid patients in regaining lost abilities after experiencing a medical condition or injury. One of the most common conditions Dr. Troll treats is carpal tunnel syndrome. He sees patients on a referral basis at Story Medical.

"Dr. Troll is an excellent physician and a great addition to the medical staff at Story Medical," says Nate Thompson, Story Medical CEO. "This represents a new specialty at the medical center and offers our community members an option for care that is close to home for a number of common ailments."

Story Medical Clinic Maxwell Now Provides Care 5 Days a Week

Since 1996, Story Medical has proudly offered primary care services from its clinic just off of Main Street in Maxwell. Today, Story Medical is redoubling its commitment to the community by expanding the clinic space and providing care five days a week.

Michelle Jans, PA-C, who has served as a provider in the Emergency Department at Story Medical since 2011 now staffs the clinic Monday through Friday. Michelle, who is a resident of Maxwell, is excited about expanding access to care in the community.

"Offering complete care close to home in communities like Maxwell is important," Jans says. "For many of our rural residents, especially those with limited means, it is not practical to travel long distances to receive care. As a result, many of them go without which often leads to a cascading number of health issues that could have been effectively managed had they sought care earlier. The people of Maxwell, Collins and

the surrounding towns are my neighbors and I look forward to serving them."

Last year, Story Medical purchased the building the clinic is located in, allowing for the expansion planning to begin. In addition to adding space for exam rooms and treatment, the project will cosmetically update the facility.

"We are proud to be making a significant investment in the health of Story County's rural communities," says CEO Nate Thompson. "We are committed to increasing access to care and we are confident Michelle is the perfect provider to oversee the growth of services in Maxwell."

Jans began seeing patients August 10. The clinic, which has been open three days a week in recent years, is open from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday-Thursday and from 8 to 11 a.m. on Friday. Jans offers primary care services for patients of all ages including well child checks, immunizations, care for acute illness and injuries, annual checkups and more.
