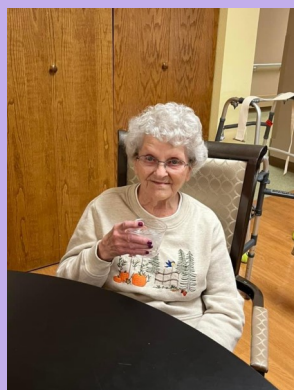

We will have our transport van and bus moving residents between locations and we also have four moving trucks scheduled for those two days. We need to account for every resident when they leave the old facility and arrive at the new facility.

We welcome you to visit your loved one the evening of their move to ensure they are doing well and getting settled in. We just need to keep the traffic during the day to a minimum to ensure a smooth transition of residents and belongings.

After the Move

- **Family Visits:** We encourage your visits during the initial adjustment period to help your loved one feel comfortable and supported.

- **Ongoing Communication:** Please ensure your preferred contact details are on file so we can provide updates and stay connected with you regularly.

Resident Orientation: Our team will work closely with all residents to ensure they are comfortable with the new environment and daily routines.

Dates to Remember

November 1st – we will have the final household assignments for staff and resident rooms

November 4th – Open House 5pm – 7pm

November 8th and 11th – Resident tours (residents only)

November 13th through 17th – family can make appointments to set up resident rooms (evening and weekend hours will be limited, but available and communicated closer to that date)

November 18th and 19th – moving residents

We are WEEKS away from our Move!!

Dear Resident Representatives,

We are excited to announce that the new Story Medical Senior Care is almost complete and we will be transitioning to our upgraded home November 18th and 19th! This facility is designed to provide a more comfortable and enriching environment for all our residents. We understand that moving can bring both excitement and challenges, and we are committed to making this transition as seamless as possible.

Our public open house is scheduled for November 4th from 5pm – 7pm. The open house will be held in only one of the households so we will not be able to take people to specific resident rooms. However, we will have more opportunities for family members to get into the new facility the week prior to our move if you would like to assist with setting up and organizing resident rooms. We ask that you do not hang anything on the walls. Maintenance will be responsible for that. You will work with them on placement of items.

To ensure a smooth transition, we kindly ask for your assistance in completing a few important steps prior to the move.

Steps to Complete Before the Move

- 1. **Assist with packing up your loved one’s belongings.**
 - o We will provide boxes, markers, and packing tape.
 - o Please pack up any items that you wish to move to the new facility. Please go through all clothing to make sure it is in good shape and remove clothing that is too big or small. Reminder that we will not have the storage space that we currently have so please be mindful of what items will be moving, versus what items will need to be taken home with you. Each resident room will have a bed, nightstand, dresser, and TV provided. Each room also has a closet, and the bathroom will have a place for all toiletries.
 - o Please label the box with the resident’s full name.
 - o Notify the nurse to leave a message for Cindy Rolph that there are boxes to be removed from the resident’s room for the new facility. Cindy will keep all belongings in a designated storage room and when we have keys to the new facility our maintenance team will begin moving boxes over to the resident’s new room.
 - o If there are any additional personal belongings to be transferred, please let us know in advance to assist with planning.
 - o If there are items that you would like to dispose of that aren’t too large you may use our dumpster on the west side of the building (old ER parking lot).
 - o If you are unable to be here to assist with packing and would like us to do so please call Cindy Rolph at 515-382-7004 or Kristie Stensland at 515-382-7019.

Resident Tours

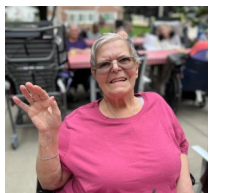
Residents will be able to tour the new facility! 3 separate times have been scheduled, make sure you get signed up for 1 of the time slots available!
