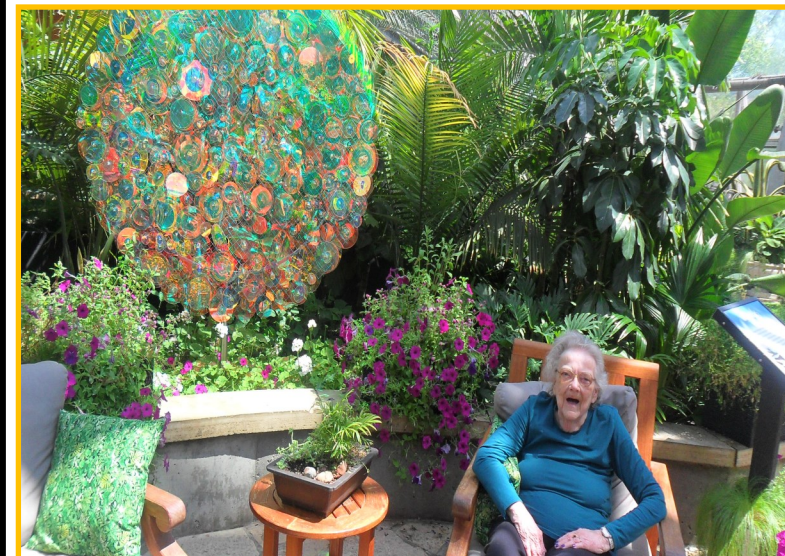
Thank you to all of the staff on the 4th of July for helping get the majority of our residents outside to see the parade!

August 29th: We will have Olympic Practice— bean bag toss— in the second floor dining room at 1:30 pm!

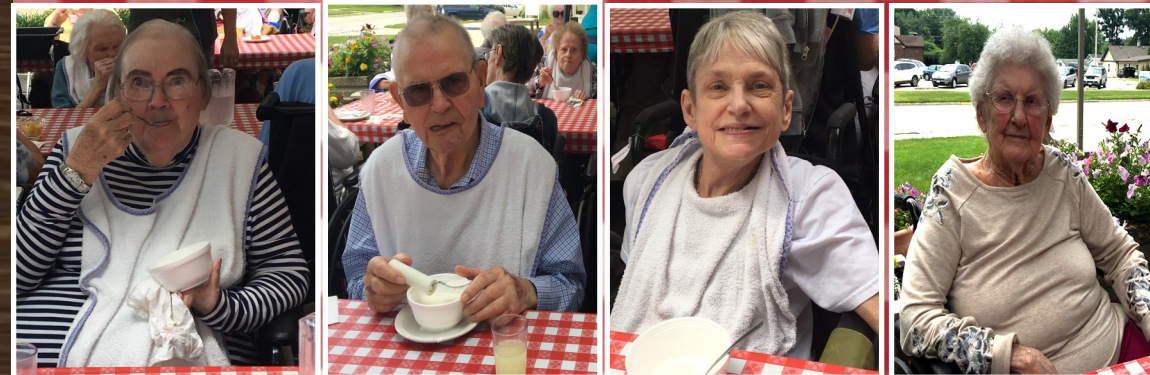
August 29th: We will be enjoying some wine and trivia at 3:00 pm!

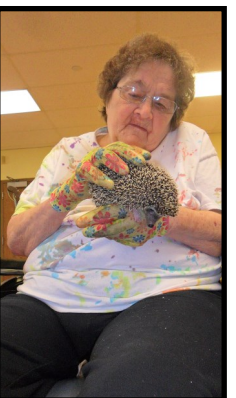
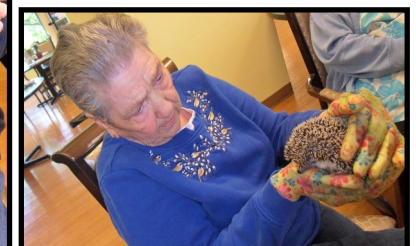
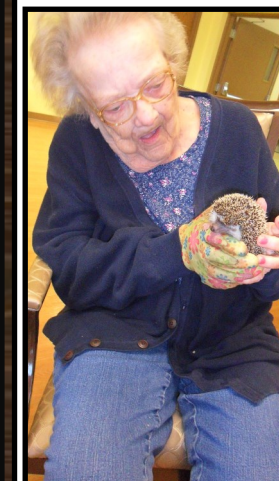
