Pet Therapy!!

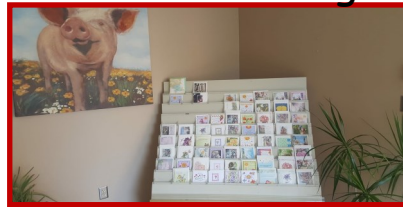

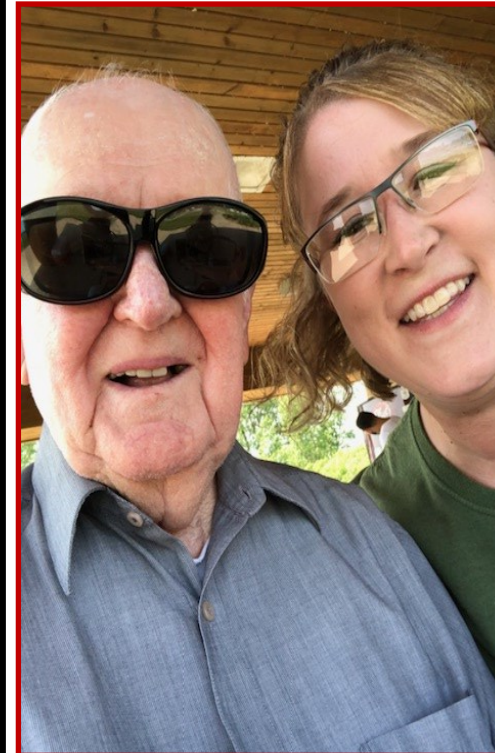


July Shout Out!

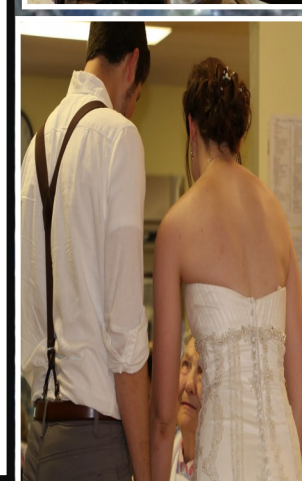
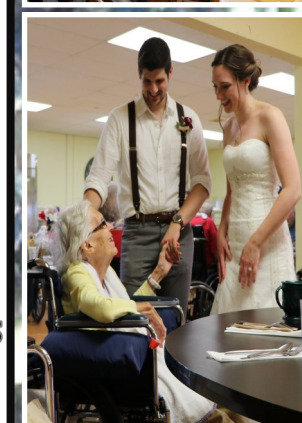
