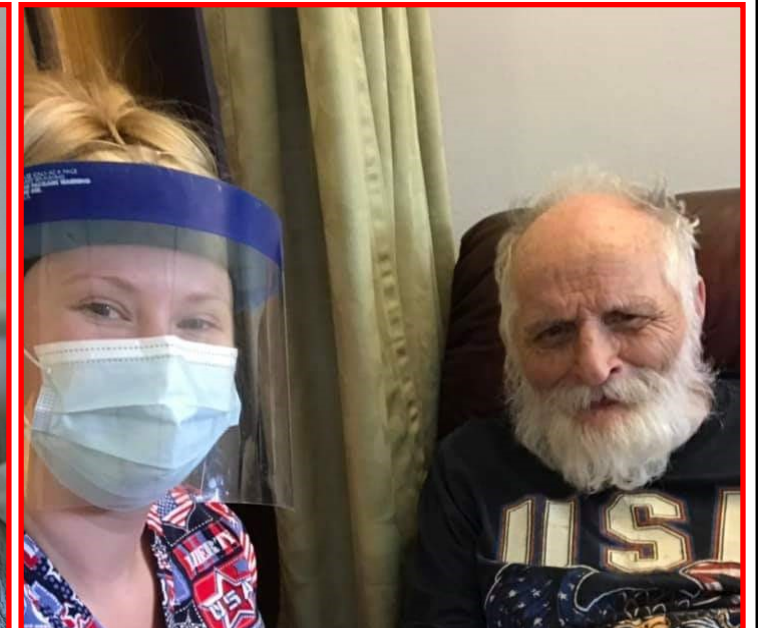

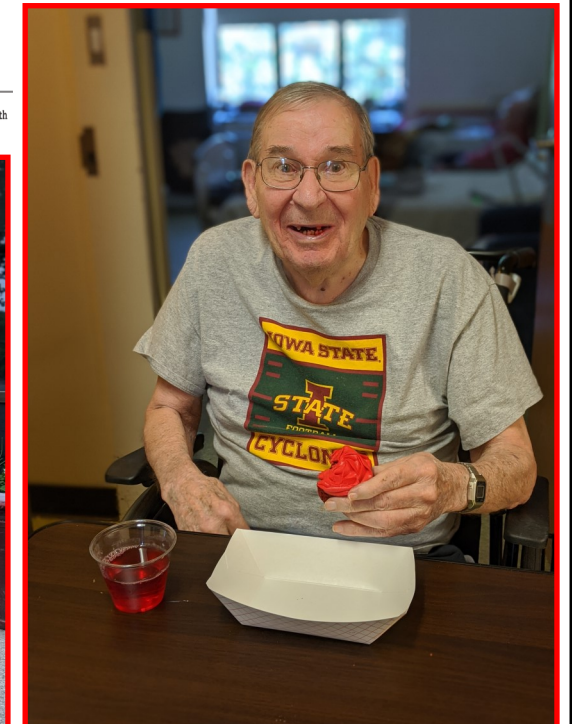

We floated down the hallways and made some delicious floats for our peeps! They chose between strawberry and root beer and enjoyed the Malt Shop music!

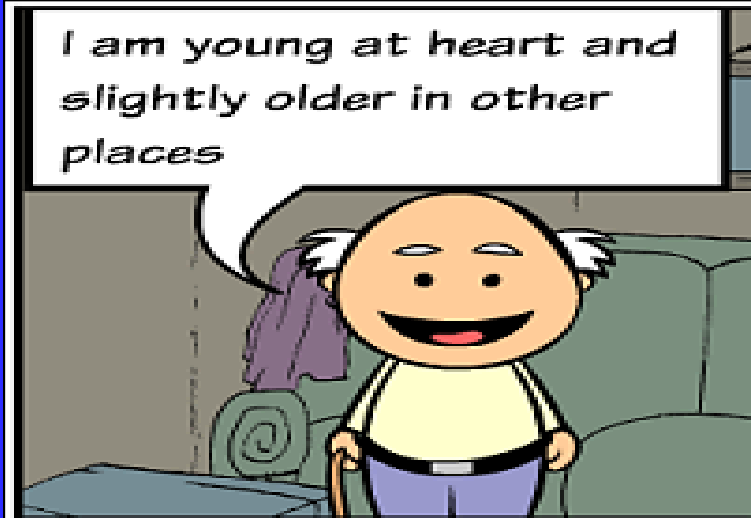

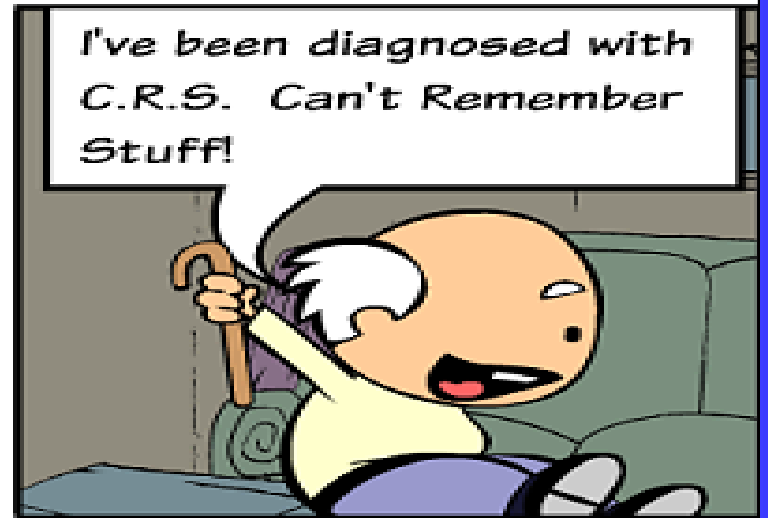
