October 26th: Come learn about Willie Nelson in the afternoon!



October 27th: Hang out with Blaire and Susie again in the morning!

October 31st: Come on out in the afternoon for our Halloween Party!






We enjoyed playing some sports games on the Nintendo Switch while enjoying some Oreos!
