In an effort to follow regulations and keep our residents' safety as our #1 priority, you will notice we will be contacting you regarding side rails on our beds. It is the recommendation of our management company, Western Homes, that we don't have any side rails on our beds. There have been serious entrapment injuries at other facilities which has driven CMS (Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services) to tighten regulations regarding side rails. It is our responsibility to complete a quarterly side rail assessment on all residents and to have their resident representative sign the consent annually.


